About us

Key Responsibilities

- 1. Ensure designated areas, both indoors and outdoors, are free of hazards and safe for daily operations.
- 2. Model appropriate behavior and language at all times.
- 3. Collaborate in planning sessions with Summer Program staff as required.
- 4. Prepare all necessary equipment and resources for daily programming.
- 5. Communicate any resource, training, equipment replacement or purchase, or supply needs to the Executive Committee to maintain an innovative and developmentally appropriate environment.
- 6. Handle setup and take-down of program equipment daily.
- Assist in marketing the summer program through various channels such as social media, posters, banners, etc.
- 8. Maintain an up-to-date registration list, ensure waivers are properly completed, and communicate participants' needs to staff.
- 9. Ensure all program fees are paid prior to program start and communicate any registration challenges with the Executive Committee.
- 10. Maintain attendance reports as required.
- 11. Address behavior concerns with participants directly in a positive format, involving parents or guardians as needed. Utilize positive behavior management strategies to handle challenging behaviors and communication exchanges.
- 12. Provide understanding and responsiveness to all patrons with program concerns and feedback.
- 13. Distribute evaluation forms to participants and submit all feedback to the Executive Committee.
- 14. Remain flexible and open to learning new skills.
- 15. Communicate effectively via email, phone, and in-person with co-workers and supervisor.

16. Attend meetings and services as scheduled. Provide a year-end report of recommendations.

Qualifications

- 1. Previous experience working with children or in a camp setting preferred.
- 2. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- 3. Strong organizational and planning skills.
- 4. Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- 5. Flexibility and willingness to learn new skills.
- 6. Valid CPR and First Aid certification or willingness to obtain.
- 7. Background check clearance.
